In light of recent events occurring in the Ukraine, members of Calvary and the Deacons have expressed a desire to help. We are asking the congregation to prayerfully consider donating to the special collection today, which has changed and will be going to **World Renew Ukraine Response**.

"World Renew has joined the Humanitarian Coalition's joint appeal for the Ukraine Crisis through our membership in the Canadian Foodgrains Bank.

We are working with our global networks in the region to respond to the needs of vulnerable families impacted by the conflict in Ukraine.

We are supporting these peer organizations by providing essential items for people fleeing for safety to neighbouring countries.
