July 17 - World Renew – Clean Water Sunday

Clean water is essential to good health, but for 2.4 billion people globally clean water is only a dream. When you give to World Renew, you can help make that dream a reality. We help communities establish safe, consistent water sources and teach families proper sanitation and hygiene practices.

Over the years, OIM has grown from a strictly 'charity' model of outreach to one focused on building a supportive community that encourages individuals to move onto the next level of development through a strength-based approach.

Each of our services and programs serve this purpose, beginning with street outreach and our drop-in services – where we offer emergency provisions, build relationships and offer support where individuals are encouraged to build on their strengths and move towards greater autonomy and self-sufficiency.

Our goal is to demonstrate to the members of our community that every person has intrinsic value and has inner strengths, skills and talents that offer individuals hope for change.

July 31 - Ministry Shares: Ministry Shares are collected monthly to assist the work of the many ministries of the Christian Reformed Church. 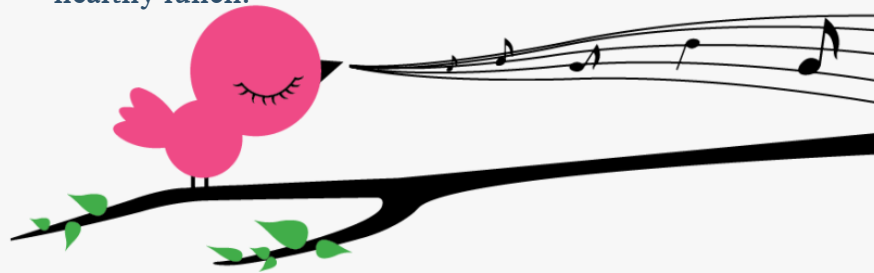
