OUR OFFERINGS:

Today - Ministry Shares - Instead of setting a specific amount per member, each congregation will prayerfully consider how much it can contribute towards our shared ministry efforts.

Ministry shares are an amazingly efficient and stewardly way for us to accomplish ministry together. Over the years, as Synod decided to start new programs, we've used ministry shares as a way of enabling all our congregations to contribute towards the costs. In this way, every initiative is truly part of our shared ministry.

What happens if my church doesn't give?

Currently, churches are contributing less than 60% of the requested amount for ministry. This means fewer funds are available for: • Supporting new church plants • Producing new resources for children's ministry • Training new pastors and supporting those already in ministry • Resourcing chaplains as they serve populations in crisis • Producing resources to revitalize worship in congregations • Equipping churches in abuse prevention, disability awareness, and racial reconciliation • Sharing the gospel in new ministry fields. With the new system proposed by Synod in 2019, ministry budgets will be set based on what is pledged from churches. If this amount is less than what is currently received, important ministry will need to be cut.

December 25 - World Renew - Cambodia (Sovann Neth) - The people of Cambodia have been left with a daunting legacy. Three years of devastation under the Pol Pot regime saw one-third of its people die, followed by another 15 years of civil war. Since the first election in 1993, the country has worked hard to rebuild and retrain communities and restore confidence and trust in leadership. World Renew is careful not to dominate the development process. Through training in governance

January 01 2023 - Harvest House



Harvest House Ministries was founded in 1979 by three Christian businessmen, who recognized the need to provide a Christ-centered home for young men struggling with addiction to alcohol and drugs. Carrying on this vision, the mission of Harvest House is: To rehabilitate young men who are chemically dependent, to instill in them self-discipline, and to reintegrate them into society by an inner change brought about by faith in Jesus Christ.

Men from all walks of life, including those with histories of relapse, criminal activity, and imprisonment, are welcomed into the program. What began as a small home for eight men on Belmont Avenue has grown to include a 24-bed main facility and an additional 4 re-entry houses. Over this time, Harvest House has maintained its purpose of providing men addicted to drugs and alcohol with an opportunity to turn their lives around. https://www.harvesthouse.org/

A Peace/Prayer Candle Tradition

In 1985, the Rev. Blair R. Monie, pastor of the first Presbyterian Church (York, Pennsylvania) visited the Soviet Union. In the small town of Voronezh, he was approached by an old woman who pressed a small sum of money into his hand and requested that he do something for World Peace. He recognized a deep desire and strong devotion in her eyes and in her voice and determined he would do something special when he returned to the United States.

What could he do with three rubles? After much thought he purchased a small votive candle, placed in on the Communion Table and lit it. On hearing his story, his congregations agreed to make it a permanent accessory of the chancel and purchased a supply of votive candles so that they would make a "peace candle" available to any visitor wishing to take it back to his/her congregation.

This small non-threatening symbol of peace helps them to be praying for people and to play their part as peacemakers as Jesus Christ called them, and us, to do. Today candles burn in England, Australia, Canada, Ireland, Kuwait, South Africa, and Denmark.
