Update from the Seafarers' Ministry

The Ministry to Seafarers (M2S) has adopted a new Vision Statement and is setting strategic goals to broaden its impact. As part of this renewed direction, M2S is actively seeking more partners—both churches and individuals—to support this vital ministry.

This year's joint Cabane à Sucre fundraiser with Mariners' House raised \$15,000 for each organization. Yet, M2S continues to face a budget shortfall, finishing 2024 with a \$37,000 deficit. Donations can be made by e-transfer (donations@ministrytoseafarers.org), PayPal Giving Fund, CanadaHelps, or by cheque. To simplify your giving, consider setting up an account with Christian Stewardship Services to receive one annual tax receipt for all donations. Visit our Donate page or the CSS MemberNET site for details. Since January, 80 new people have been introduced to the ministry through port and Centre tours. At Easter, we hosted 29 guests, including four seafarers, for a joyful potluck. One seafarer shared, "I feel safe here. I don't feel like anyone wants anything from me."
