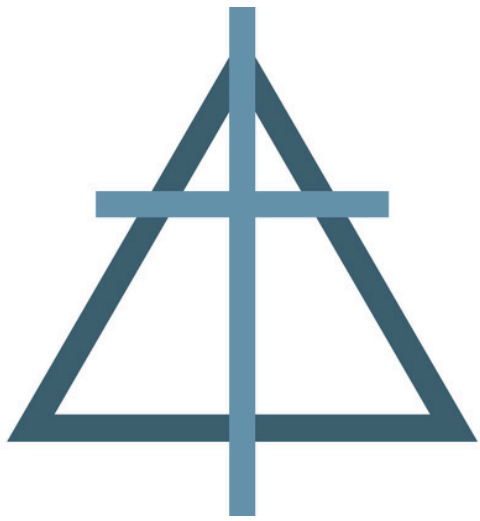
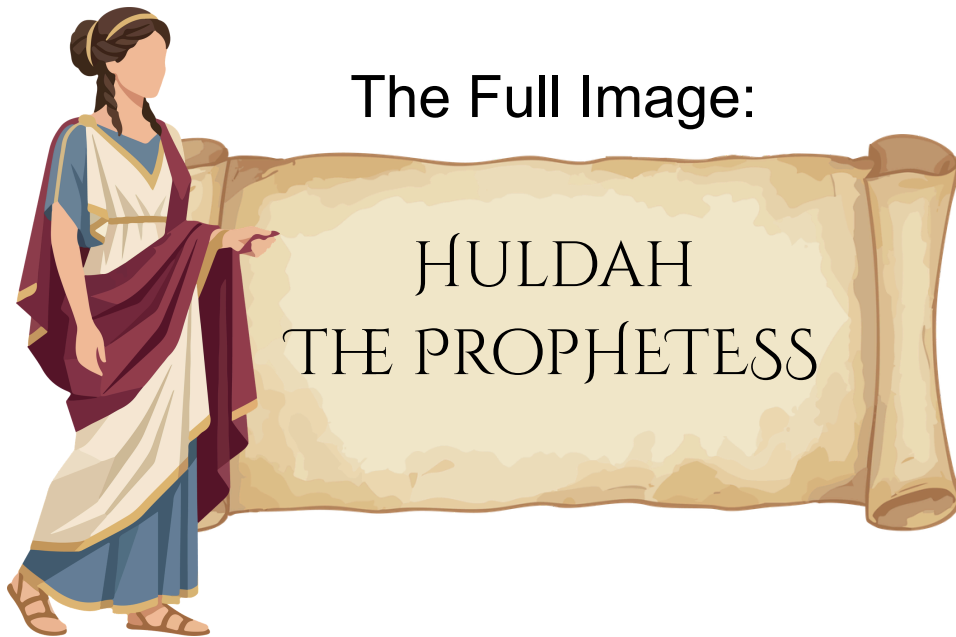

As wildfires continue to impact communities across Canada, many individuals and families have been forced to leave their homes, uncertain of when, or if they will be able to return. Please pray for the:

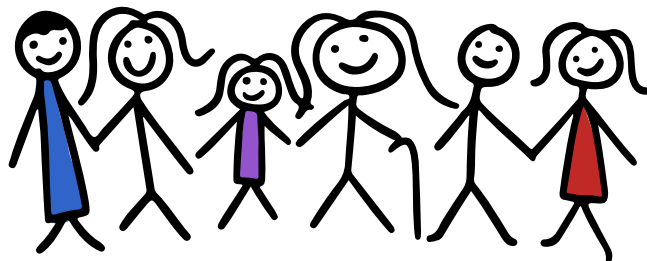
- Elders and community members caring for one another in these crises
